This book highlights the rarity of the Limestone Fynbos Flora. The village of Vermaaklikheid and its surrounds lies centrally within an area of limestone fynbos and is consequently an important area for biological conservation.

Vermaaklikheid is located in a geomorphological zone identified as the Riversdale Coastal Plain, which lies south of the Langeberg Mountains, stretching from the Duiwenhoks River in the west to the Gouritz River in the east. It contains 54% of all Limestone Fynbos, either within or immediately adjacent to it.
